Albert was born in Leicester in 1879, the son of William and Mary Ann Kennell. Albert married Susan Martin at the age of 21 on 22nd December 1900 and lived with his wife's family at 13/15 Freemans Lane, Burbage following their marriage.

By 1911, Albert and Susan had set up their own home in Burbage and have a 9-year-old daughter, Mabel Alice Kennell; at this time Albert was employed as a Hatter.

Albert enlisted with the 4th Battalion of Leicestershire Regiment on 31st May 1915 and served with the Leicester's until discharged through ill-health on 23rd April 1917 as "no longer physically fit for war service".
